Entries The event will be open to all members of BSA and all visitors who are

members of the Heron Dinghy Class Association. All competing boats shall hold a valid measurement certificate (or Log Book) and comply with the class

rules.

Entry fee £10 for all visitors

Registration On Saturday 11th May, before the first start

Briefing 10:15 on the day, outside the Boathouse Café. Extra briefings may be held at

the discretion of the Race Officer.

Schedule of races It is hoped to run three races. No warning signals will be given after 16:00.

First start Not before 11:00

Starting procedure Rule 26 will apply. Single-handed and crewed boats will start together.

Scoring and results
The results will be calculated on handicap. Different handicaps will be used

for single-handed and double-handed boats.

The scoring system will be as indicated in RRS Appendix A RYA 2017-2020.

At the finish any boat which is not on the same lap as the first finisher will be required to cross the finishing line and will be scored on average lap times.

RISK STATEMENT

Rule 4 of the Racing Rules of Sailing states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone."

Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:

- They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
- b) They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;
- c) They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions:
- d) Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;
- e) The provision of a race management team, patrol boats, umpires and other officials and volunteers by the organiser does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;
- f) The provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances.
